

COVID-19 GUIDELINES

Updated July 16, 2020

From the Parish Council – The health of our church family is of the utmost importance. The following guidelines are based on information from the Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment, Boulder County Public Health, and guidance from our Hierarch, Metropolitan Isaiah of Denver.

We ask that those attending services please be familiar with and be prepared to follow the guidelines. Further details on current guidelines are available in the Narthex.

ATTENDANCE

If you have been exposed to the corona-virus, are experiencing symptoms, or are in a high-risk group, we respectfully ask you to remain at home.

MASKS

Masks must be worn throughout the entirety of any service and while entering and exiting the church.

Exceptions: Children age 10 and younger and those who cannot medically tolerate a face covering.

SEATING

Pews with **BLUE CROSSES** are open for seating and identify which end of the pew is to be used.

Please be aware of those around you and take any additional measures needed to maintain 6 feet or more distance.

Ask an Usher if you need assistance in finding available seating.

VENERATION OF ICONS

Do not kiss or touch any Icons.

Venerate icons by bowing your head and making the sign of the cross.

RECEIVING COMMUNION

Wait for Ushers to direct you as to when to exit your pew and guide you on how to proceed. Families may approach together.

Masks may be temporarily removed while receiving Holy Communion.

Maintain a distance of 6 feet from the faithful preceding you.

ENTERING & EXITING

If you have not signed up for the service ahead of time, please register with an Usher upon entering the church.

Enter the Church only through the open Narthex door.

Exit the church only through the south door (behind chanters).
